

# **POLICE OFFICER & DEPUTY SHERIFF**

The Hall County Sheriff's Office and the City of Hastings Police Department are recruiting candidates for the position of law enforcement officers. A joint application and testing process will be conducted by appointment only. The current application deadline is April 6, 2012, for April 12, 13 or 14 testing. Initial testing for both agencies will take place at the Hastings Police Department.

Persons interested in applying must be 21 years of age by commission date; be in good physical condition; have a valid driver's license; have a high school diploma or GED; and be of good moral character with no felony conviction. Other standards apply.

## **Test Information**

Applicants will take a multiple-choice test followed by two essay questions. Both Hall County and the City of Hastings will conduct mini-interviews with those passing the test. Hastings will schedule oral board interviews for later that day for those continuing in the process.

Note: The TABE will NOT be offered this year. It is the applicant's responsibility to pass the test prior to being hired. This does not mean you can not apply. Please contact the NLETC at 308-385-6030 for information on taking this test.

## **Hall County Information**

Screening Interview: Following the written testing, applicants who pass the written test will meet with a Hall County representative. Each Hall County applicant will need to attend one of these interviews.

Physical agility testing will take place on April 14<sup>th</sup> following the written test that day. Time and location of the testing will be announced on the date of the written test.



Applicants passing all phases of this testing will be invited back for an oral exam at the Hall County Sheriff's Office on April 17, 2012. Appointment times will be set up the day of the written testing.
