

INVITATION TO BIDERS

TIRE RECYCLING

Competitive Sealed Bids will be received by the Hall County Clerk at 121 South Pine Street in Grand Island, Nebraska for TIRE RECYCLING.

Pending award of a grant, Hall County will hold a Scrap Tire Cleanup Day, possibly on April 22, 2023. Bidders are to pick up tires the week following the event. The bid is to include a price per ton for 250 tons of scrap tires. Bid information needs to include intended recycling use for the tires. Bids will only be accepted from scrap tire haulers permitted by the State of Nebraska.

Bidder is to load, transport and recycle tires at yard behind the Hall County Weed Authority at 2807 West 2nd Street in Grand Island and at the Hall County Yard located at the intersection of 80th Road and Guenther Road (southwest of Alda, Nebraska).

Bids will be publicly opened at the Hall County Board of Commissioners Room located in the Hall County Administration Building at 121 South Pine Street in Grand Island, Nebraska.

No bid may be withdrawn within a period of ninety (90) days after the date fixed for bid opening.

Hall County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or parts of thereof and award bids as may be deemed to the best interest of the County. Bids will be evaluated with competitive bidding considerations under NE Statutes 23-3110.

A purchase order will be issued to the awarded bidder if and when the grant is approved by the State of Nebraska Department of Environment & Energy.

The successful bidder shall comply with all applicable State fair labor standards in the execution of this contract as required by Section 73-102, R.R.S. and also comply with the provisions of Section 48-657, R.R.S. pertaining to contributions to the Unemployment Compensation Fund of the State of Nebraska.
