

FULL TIME MECHANIC POSITION

Applications are now being accepted at the Hall County Highway Department, 2900 W. 2nd Street, Grand Island, NE for the following Mechanic Position. Applications will be accepted until November 17, 2017 and may be obtained Monday thru Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Starting wage for this position will be \$17.54/Hr.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Under the supervision of the Mechanic Supervisor, is responsible for work of average difficulty in the repair and maintenance of heavy construction equipment; performs any related work as required, repair and maintenance of both and gasoline and diesel-powered equipment, including, but not limited to, front end loaders, bulldozers, motor graders, trucks, automobiles, trucks , spraying equipment, mowers, and chain saws; tunes and adjusts carburetors, ignition systems, starters and transmissions, repair of electrical systems, wiring, lights, and accessories. Lubricates equipment, changes oil and filters, does both arc and acetylene welding, repairs flat tires, operates heavy equipment when needed, and can be assigned to perform duties in any of the job categories of the Hall County Public Works Department.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

Knowledge of heavy equipment mechanics, standard tools, materials, and practices to repair and maintain construction equipment; knowledge of hazards and safety precautions associated with the trade.

Skill in examining and correcting mechanical failures and in the use and care of tools and equipment.

Ability to analyze mechanical and electrical problems, to instruct others in minor repairs, and to do welding jobs incidental to mechanical work and any other related work as needed.

PRE-EMPLOYMENT KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of mechanical principles and routine repairs on construction equipment, the standard tools, materials, and practices uses in making such repairs; knowledge of hazards and safety precautions of the trade.

Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions to fill out work sheets, to do manual labor involving bending, lifting, carrying at least 50 pounds, and other similar motions and under adverse weather conditions.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Licensed to operate a motor vehicle in the State of Nebraska and ability to obtain a class A CDL license with tank endorsement in the State of Nebraska.
