

## **Hall County Equipment Operator**

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Must be 18 years of age and have a good driving record. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds, climb, bend and, stoop, work in outdoor temperature extremes and work around high speed traffic. A Class A Commercial Driver's License is required within 60 days of employment. Possession of a valid Hazardous Material endorsement and/or Tanker endorsement may be required for certain positions within this classification. Must be able to report to work outside scheduled work hours for snow and other highway emergencies within 30 minutes under normal driving conditions. Must be a safe worker who is team oriented.

### **Essential Duties:**

Operates trucks and other light equipment to complete highway maintenance work. Operates post drivers for the installation of signs, fences and guardrails and other hand held power and manually operated tools. Performs tree trimming and brush cutting. Performs manual labor for concrete and bituminous patching and sealing of cracks in highways and structures. Manually provides highway traffic control for construction and maintenance projects according to safety procedures. Physically moves, loads and unloads highway materials and supplies weighing up to 50 pounds. Completes routine and general maintenance and mechanical repair of equipment. Performs snow removal, maintains yards and performs building maintenance and cleaning. May apply chemicals of selective and non-selective herbicide spray to highway right-of-way. Employees who demonstrate proficiency will perform skilled work in the operation of heavy road construction, and maintenance equipment. Employees in this class may operate such equipment as motor graders, tandem axle trucks, tractor/trailer (lowboy) rigs, backhoes, bulldozers and heavy duty excavators, water truck, paint striper truck, drag line, heavy tractor, as a regular assignment, light and heavy trucks, tractors and related automotive equipment as well as in the general construction of bridges and culverts. Work involves assisting in all phases of construction of wooden, concrete, or steel bridges and the installation of culverts including placing concrete tile and corrugated metal pipe (CMP). Employees may perform general laboring duties on a variety of construction type activities as well as manual road maintenance activities, and may supervise employees assigned as helpers. Work is supervised by a working foreman.
