

Hall County Park Maintenance Facility/Security Worker

NATURE OF WORK

This is skilled work in the supervision and registration of campers, security and control of public use, and in the repair and maintenance of the park facilities and equipment.

Work involves responsibility for the routine care of lawns and other park facilities. Work also involves supervising volunteers and seasonal employees; registering and collecting park fees from campers; performing general maintenance tasks including repairing and maintaining lawn care and irrigation equipment, playground, restrooms and recreational equipment, and park building and facilities and other duties as assigned by the Facilities Director. Work is performed under the general supervision of the administrative superior with work reviewed in the form of visual inspections, reports and general public commentary.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Performs necessary janitorial duties to maintain a clean and healthy public environment.

Performs electrical, carpentry and concrete/masonry work as assigned including painting exteriors and interiors.

Perform lawn care such as mowing, trimming, trees and shrub pruning, snow removal on sidewalks and parking lots.

Performs duties required to maintain and install irrigation system, with supervision.

Register and collect park fees from campers.

Ensures the public compliance with park regulations and open and closes gates as required.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS

Knowledge of the rules and regulations governing Public Park facilitates and services.

Knowledge of building repair and maintenance methods and procedures.

Knowledge on the following vehicles or equipment; loader, tractors, bucket truck, grinder, electric saw, mosquito control foggers and other basic equipment.

Knowledge of chemicals used and how to read the material data safety sheet.

Ability to register and collect park fees from campers.

Ability to monitor parks security and ensures public compliance with park regulations.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and the general public.

Ability to carry out written and oral instructions on varied jobs.

Skills in the operation of lawn equipment, application equipment and snow equipment.

DESIRABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from a senior high school and experience in one or more of the building trades.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from a senior high school or equivalent and some experience in one or more of the building trades or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the identified knowledge, skills and abilities.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Must have a valid State of Nebraska driver's license.

Ability to obtain a CPR certification card.

Ability to obtain a State of Nebraska Pesticide License.

Ability to obtain a State of Nebraska Grade 5 Water Operators License.
